Behold the Lamb of God

Video 1: Kate speaks on the Lamb of God

John tells us to behold the Lamb of God, to gaze, to look until we see. As you have looked today, what have you seen?

Peter tells us that we were redeemed “*with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. He was chosen before the creation of the world but was revealed in these last times for your sake.*” *1 Peter 1:18-20*

Does it change how you value yourself when you see that God always planned to give himself as a sacrifice to redeem you?

The revelation of God as the Lamb shows us that self-giving, sacrificial love is God’s eternal nature. Why do we sometimes think that God would withhold good things from us?

What struck you in what Ellie said?

Read Hebrews 10:14. *For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.*

Discuss how God has made us perfect through his sacrifice for us.

Hebrews 9:14 says that the blood of the Lamb cleanses our consciences. Why is it then that Christians so often struggle with feeling guilt and shame?

What helps you to receive the abundance of God’s grace so that you can reign in life? (Romans 5:17)

Video 3: Jane Williams speaks on the humility of Christ.

How can we hold together the truths that God is both infinitely powerful and gently humble?

The way of the world is usually to grab and climb higher. The Lamb takes the opposite approach. How would my life be different if I follow the Lamb wherever he goes? (Revelation 14:4)
